

ANNUAL MEETING REPORT ON CLASSES AND MEMBERSHIP FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF 2017-2018*

*This report is for a rough comparison purposes between sessions and does not include the impact of scholarships and free teacher memberships.

By the end of our year we had a total of 566 members of which 127 were new to Senior College.

- The summer of 2017 we had *five* one day classes which 74 enrolled in which netted Senior College approximately \$2,160 in course fees excluding scholarships granted.
- The fall of 2017 we had *eight* morning classes with 228 enrolled and *seven* afternoon classes with 234 enrolled plus *two* one day classes with 31 enrolled which netted Senior College \$17,100 for class fees plus approximately \$890 for membership fees. (10 vouchers were used due to previous cancellations of the French classes). Again this is a rough figure and excludes scholarships.
- The Winterim of 2018 we had *seven* classes in the morning (due to the cancellation of Mailloux's class) with 134 enrolled and *eight* afternoon classes 209 enrolled plus *one* (1) one day class with 6 enrolled which netted Senior College roughly \$10,260 in class fees and \$2,535 in membership fees excluding scholarships.
- The spring of 2018 we had *eight* morning classes with 160 enrolled and *eight* afternoon classes with 132 students enrolled plus *three* one day classes (due the cancelation of the orchid course) with 28 enrolled netting Senior College **\$11,060** netting Senior College approximately in class fees and \$2,500 in membership fees.
- In summary the fiscal year had:
 - 11 *one* day classes
 - 31 six week classes
 - 15 four week classes
